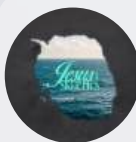

READY TO LAUNCH

A CHURCH POSITIONED FOR REVIVAL

THE EARLY CHURCH DIDN'T JUST HOPE FOR REVIVAL—THEY POSITIONED THEMSELVES FOR IT. THEY WERE UNIFIED IN PRAYER, FILLED WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT, AND BOLD IN THEIR MISSION. AS WE LAUNCH INTO THIS NEW SEASON AT ALSTON'S CORNER, WE MUST ASK OURSELVES: ARE WE TRULY READY FOR GOD TO MOVE IN THE SAME WAY? ARE WE POSITIONING OURSELVES WITH EXPECTATION, OBEDIENCE, AND HUNGER FOR REVIVAL?

ACTS 2:41 TELLS US THAT 3,000 PEOPLE WERE ADDED TO THE CHURCH IN A SINGLE DAY, AND ACTS 2:47 SAYS THAT PEOPLE WERE BEING SAVED DAILY. THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT WAS UNDENIABLE, AND THE EARLY BELIEVERS LIVED WITH URGENCY. THEY WEREN'T JUST ATTENDING CHURCH—THEY WERE BEING THE CHURCH EVERYWHERE THEY WENT. IMAGINE FOR A MOMENT IF THAT HAPPENED HERE. IMAGINE HUNDREDS, EVEN THOUSANDS OF NEW DISCIPLES, SET ON FIRE FOR GOD, FILLING OUR WORKPLACES, SCHOOLS, AND NEIGHBORHOODS. IMAGINE MIRACLES BREAKING OUT, ADDICTIONS BREAKING OFF, AND LIVES BEING TRANSFORMED DAILY. THIS WAS THE REALITY OF THE EARLY CHURCH—AND IT CAN STILL BE OURS TODAY.

WE SERVE THE SAME GOD. HIS POWER HAS NOT CHANGED (MALACHI 3:6). WE ARE FILLED WITH THE SAME HOLY SPIRIT THAT EMPOWERED THE EARLY BELIEVERS (ACTS 1:8). WE CARRY THE SAME MISSION TO PREACH THE GOSPEL AND MAKE DISCIPLES (MATTHEW 28:19). SO WHAT'S STOPPING US? THE ONLY THING THAT CAN HOLD US BACK IS OUR LEVEL OF EXPECTATION, OBEDIENCE, AND HUNGER FOR REVIVAL. IF WE WANT TO SEE GOD MOVE IN A WAY WE'VE NEVER SEEN BEFORE, WE MUST SEEK, SURRENDER, AND STEP OUT IN FAITH LIKE NEVER BEFORE.

BUT REVIVAL ISN'T JUST ABOUT WAITING—IT'S ABOUT TAKING ACTION. THE EARLY CHURCH WAS INTENTIONAL ABOUT REACHING PEOPLE. IF WE WANT TO SEE OUR COMMUNITY TRANSFORMED, WE NEED TO BE THE HANDS AND FEET OF JESUS IN PRACTICAL WAYS:

1) START CONVERSATIONS—SHARE YOUR TESTIMONY WITH SOMEONE WHO NEEDS HOPE.

2) BE BOLD IN INVITING—DON'T JUST INVITE PEOPLE TO CHURCH; INVITE THEM INTO YOUR LIFE.

3) LOOK FOR NEEDS AND MEET THEM—BE THE FIRST TO SERVE, LOVE, AND GIVE.

4) LIVE OUT THE GOSPEL DAILY—YOUR ACTIONS SHOULD PREACH JUST AS LOUD AS YOUR WORDS.

REVIVAL BEGINS WHEN WE TAKE PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE GREAT COMMISSION. ARE WE READY TO STOP JUST ATTENDING CHURCH AND START BEING THE CHURCH? GOD IS READY TO MOVE—LET'S MAKE SURE WE'RE READY TO GO WHERE HE'S LEADING.
